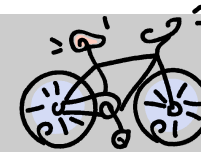

Registration is from 7:30 to 8:30 AM at the Glenwood City Park (across from the Lakeside Ballroom– 180 S. Lakeshore DR).

Riders will have a choice of 3 routes (mileage is approximate):

Lake & Woods Trail

The first leg of the tour will entail an 20 mile* route around Lake Minnewaska. The tour will start out on the bike path to Starbuck (food stop) and continue on around the lake. There will be some rolling hills involved but the pace will be relaxed enough to enjoy beautiful Lake Minnewaska. This is the perfect ride to do with your whole family. *(about 1 1/2 hours average ride)*

Prairie Trail

The second leg of the tour will continue on the new bike path to Villard (for an additional 20 miles*) where you will be able to stop and see the progress of the Habitat house being built before heading back to Glenwood. There will be food/bathroom stops provided along the route for the riders.

Out & About Trail

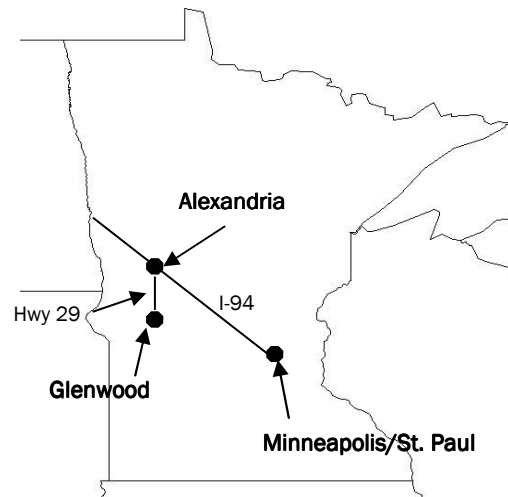
This third leg of the tour was new in 2009. Going from Villard out into beautiful countryside North and West of Glenwood. This ride entails a total of 70 miles*. There will be pit stops provided along the way as you wander your way thru rolling prairie back to Glenwood.

The tour concludes back at the Glenwood City Park with refreshments available to all riders.

(*all miles are approximate)

Maps of the route will be provided and marked. Sag service, food stops, and T-Shirts will be available to participants. Free showers available at Glenwood City Beach after the ride or bring your suit for a swim!

Helmets are required for all riders.



Directions From:

Sauk Center: HWY 28 into Glenwood, left onto Franklin St. S (at stoplight), one block take a right onto 1st Ave SW, two blocks and City Park is on the left.

Alexandria: HWY 29 into Glenwood, becomes Franklin St, Take right onto 1st Ave SW, two blocks and City Park is on the left.
